



Veterans' MATES Clinical Audit - Patient Review

30 ACRRM Mandatory points

Promoting Quality Use of Medicines for Veterans

GPs that complete any two **Veterans' MATES** modules and complete the essential requirements of a clinical audit, are eligible for 30 ACRRM Mandatory points.

What do I need to do?

Each Clinical Audit - Patient Review involves completing two Veterans' MATES modules. You can undertake any combination of modules from the Veterans' MATES Program from module 13 onwards. You must complete two modules to obtain 30 ACRRM Mandatory points.

For each module you must complete the following steps:

- Identification of a specific audit topic
- Identification of existing standards or establishment of standards
- Collection of data
- Comparison of own practice with standards
- Determination of changes required to improve practice
- Implementation of changes
- Evaluation of the effect of changes on practice outcomes

How do I register and obtain ACRRM PDP points?

To register for the Clinical Audit - Patient Review, return your response form in the prepaid envelope and include your ACRRM membership number. Please note: the program is available only to GPs that manage veterans selected in Veterans' MATES modules.
